



GARDEN SCHOOL LOWER DIVISION DRESS CODE

In fulfilling its mission, Garden School provides not only an excellent education, but also an excellent environment in which to learn. Proper attire contributes to that environment.

Age-appropriate clothing that is neat and tidy should be worn while at school. A good deal of individuality is permitted, and all should be dressed respectfully each day. The following are specific items that are not allowed in school:

- tank or ‘spaghetti’ strapped tops
- midriff or low-cut tops or any other revealing clothing
- leggings (unless worn with a skirt, shorts, or long shirts and sweaters)
- clothing with inappropriate writing or logos
- hats (except for religious observance)
- torn clothing (from wear or intentional)
- sleepwear items

Headphones, electronic games and cell phones may be carried but not used during class.

We are committed to the appearance of our students as an important part of the school atmosphere. The dress code is broad enough so that students can attend school comfortably and remain within its guidelines. The administration reserves the right to deem any style of dress inappropriate.

This information about the dress code is for students and their parents/guardians. While Garden believes that its students should be responsible for themselves, it is ultimately the parents/guardians who must use their good judgment when purchasing clothing and seeing their children leave for school.
